3. Candidates who enroll for the programme are required to report to the TERI School of Advanced Studies on 1 September 2020 at 9.30 a.m. for registration. An orientation programme will be held on the same day. Classes will commence on 2 September 2020.
4. This offer of admission is made to the candidate subject to his/her obtaining a Bachelor's degree or equivalent, and producing a class XII marksheet with English as a subject. Any misrepresentation or omission of facts, if detected, will lead to cancellation of admission at any point during the programme.
5. **Original mark sheets and certificates of the 10<sup>th</sup>, 10+2, CAT/MAT/GMAT/CMAT/XAT and the qualifying examination as well as the original migration certificate from the college/University last attended, are to be produced at the time of registration. A self-attested copy of each of these certificates also needs to be handed over at the time.**
6. Candidates, whose results of the bachelor's degree are awaited, are required to bring a certificate from the Registrar/Head of Department/ Head of the Institution where they are studying, stating that he/she has appeared in the qualifying exam and is expected to complete all the requirements for the qualifying degree by 1 September 2020 and are also expecting the final results of the qualifying degree by 9 November 2020.
7. At the time of orientation candidates must also bring with them three copies of a recent passport size photograph in white background.
