Selected scholars will be based at TERI SAS and are expected to commence the course for the January 2026 intake. The dual doctoral degrees are awarded by Deakin & TERI SAS upon successful completion of the requirements of both institutions.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Master's degree with a minimum CGPA of 70% and an 80% in the research thesis. Thesis should be 25-30% of the program (one full semester).
- Relevant postgraduate research experience may be taken into consideration including:
 - Independently refereed journal articles, publications, or conference papers
 - Professional reporting or prior learning o Research-related awards or prizes
 - Other evidence of research ability
- PhD course work to be completed as per the TERI SAS PhD regulation guidelines.
- Language proficiency: IELTS (Academic)/TOEFL/PTE (Academic) scores are mandatory (with a minimum overall band-score of 6.5 and with no individual band-score lower than 6.0 in IELTS)
- CSIR-UGC/NET/GATE qualified applicants are preferred

IMPORTANT NOTE:

 Current 1st year TERI SAS PhD students can also apply. However, offer letter shall be conditional on selection to successful completion of coursework as per TERI SAS PhD regulations guidelines preferably with a minimum CGPA of 7.0 & above in their 1st year

Program Benefits:

- Joint supervision will be provided to scholars by Deakin, TERI SAS faculties
- The selected candidates will receive 100% Tuition fee waiver from Deakin University, Australia
- Based on needs, selected students may have an opportunity to carry out part of their research work at Deakin University, Australia for a period of up to 12 months. Visa application fees, travel cost and living expenses will be covered by Deakin University for duration of their stay.
